WHATS YOUR SYSTEM #2?

Bradley Johnston kindly commented on board 23 from The Otago Autumn Teams played on Saturday March 25.


This board was from the top of the table round 4 clash between eventual winners McManus and runners up Eidler, both teams the only ones to be three from three, with McManus at the Home table.

McManus Matt McManus (Aust) & Sam Coutts Home NS

Opening Bid

Both Souths (Sam & Murat) exercised their discretion to get into the bidding early and put the pressure on with a 3H opening.

Not the text book play we teach at lessons, but this is the world of tournament competition.

WHY?

Looking at the hands, if South passes, West opens and EW should reach a 4S game with fairly straight forward bidding, making 5 for +650.

So South's 3H pre-empt is simply trying to make finding that contract a little more difficult.

WEST'S OPTIONS

Pass, 3S or Double seem the options available.

With North unknown and all vulnerable, stepping into the bidding battle was a risk to far for both Wests as they took the Pass option.

The pass from North was the easiest bid at the table.

EAST's OPTIONS

Holding probably the highest point count hand and knowing partner probably has some points East has an awkward choice, ie South's bid has achieved part of its goal!

East can't double as that would be for takeout and show a heart shortage, not it's longest suit!

So feeling robbed, East must decide "is the best score going to come from playing or defending? Or more succinctly, bid 3NT or Pass.

And that's exactly what happened.

- One team passed and immediately picked up +400 when 3H can only make 5 tricks.
- The other table bid 3NT, looking for +600 or better and a win on the board, and once dummy's hand was on the table game was guaranteed with overtricks likely, as long as East followed the teams' mantra priority is to make your contract; overtricks are a bonus not necessity.
 - Note West really has no choice but to pass as partner might also have an unbalanced hand but with a heart stopper and long running minor.
- So 3NT paid off with a 6 imp win on the Board for McManus.

Bragging rights however went to Eidler who took out the match narrowly 22-19.

Eidler also were the only team to go unbeaten all day, but as often is the case in Swiss teams, it is the size of the wins as much as the number of wins that determines the final winner.

Editor's Comment:

Interestingly, for those Wests not so thoughtful and/or more of the risk taking nature, a double produced a huge dividend as NS have nowhere to run; East is very happy to pass; and instead of +400, 3Hx -4 rewards EW with +1100!
