

Board 6



On a heart lead from West, the slam is set up -5 diamonds, 6 spades and KH.

Likewise the AC lead, gives you 5 diamonds, 6 spades and a club ruff.

You must also play the contract the same way on a spade or trump lead, ie win in South and ruff a club before drawing trumps.

Of course, you also need trumps to be 3/3.

Here's another hand that keeps our game interesting – this time from Kurow.

Sitting West, All Vul, you pick up this beauty:

And instantly think - Red Suit slam???

I thought this hand from Taieri was interesting.

The only making slam is diamonds, but of course the whole room were in the black suits, either NS in spades or EW in clubs.

But of course partner as dealer, opens a pre-emptive 3C, quickly followed by 3S from South.

- What's your bid?
- What would you have bid if South had bid 4S?
