

## Answers to Transfers "Bid Em Up's"

- a) 2D transfer to hearts and pass when partner bids 2H  
b) Pass  
c) 2C Stayman. Looking for a 4-4 heart fit. If opener rebids 2D or 2S will rebid 2NT. I don't show/bid the club suit.  
d) 2S (only if you agree with partner!) showing a long weak minor. Opener rebids 2NT and you can bid 3C (to play)
- a) 3NT. Maximum with 2 hearts  
b) 3H. Minimum with 3+H  
c) 4H. Maximum with 3+H  
d) Pass. Minimum with 2 hearts
- a) Transfer to spades via 2H and then raise partner to 3S (invitational) showing 6 Spades.  
b) Transfer to hearts via 2D and then raise partner to 4H  
c) Transfer to hearts via 2D and then raise partner to 4H  
NB if partner super accepts the 2D transfer by bidding 3H I will bid 6H.
- a) 3C Stayman. Looking for a 4-4 heart fit.  
b) 3D transfer to hearts and then check for aces/bid 6H.  
c) 3H Transfer to spades and then pass.  
NB if opener had started with 2C : 2D : 2N (showing 23/24) I would transfer to spades and then (punt) 4S.

## Hands

3h = SUPERACCEPT. Sure we are too high and are going off. But the opposition must make at least 3S if not 4S.

I would certainly bid 4H vulnerable at teams.

2H 2S (natural not a transfer)  
3S 4S (3S showed a minimum and was non forcing but responder has enough to go on)
- West East  
1N  
2D 2H  
2S 2N (not 4 spades or 3+ hearts, minimum)  
3N
- West East  
1N 2D  
2H 2S  
3H 4H  
3H showed a minimum(!) with 0-3S and 3+H. It was non forcing but East has enough to bid game. Game basically relies on the Ace of hearts being onside (you lead upto the hearts twice).
