'Several members have told the Club that they would like to pay their table money and tournament entry fees online. We would like to make this possible because it is undoubtedly convenient for many people but it is not something we can easily make happen overnight. We are beginning to work through what changes it would require to our website to store the data we would need. Also we need to understand if and how it would be possible to manage continuing cash payments for members wishing to keep using cash. The current scheme is very easy for the Treasurer to manage while if we use multiple collection methods we need to design a system which is able to track and reconcile everything automatically. We will let you know how things develop on this over the next few months.'
